



Cooling Assistance Program

(Federally funded and administered by Georgia Division of Family & Children Services)

Beginning April 1st at 9:30 a.m., only households where **all** adult members are 65 or older or **all** adult members are medically homebound may apply. All other low-income households may apply beginning May 1, 2022 if funds are available. Funds are limited and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Eligibility for this program is determined by the income of **all adults** living in the household (see chart below).

*There will also be limited funding for households in crisis. Households who are disconnected or are within 7 days of disconnection should call the action pact Service Center in their county for assistance. Crisis appointments will not be available through the automated or online system.
