Only households where all adult members are 65 or older or all adult members are medically homebound may apply beginning **November 1, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** All other low-income households may apply beginning December 1, 2022 if funds are available.

Funds are limited and will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Eligibility for this program is determined by the income of all adults living in the household (see chart below).
